Minutes of the January 14, 2015 Meeting

The August meeting of Chapter 59 of the **Society of Broadcast Engineers** was held January 14, 2015 at Zarda Barbeque; 11931 West 87<sup>th</sup>; Lenexa, Kansas. There were 13 in attendance. Mike Rogers, chapter chairman, was in charge

Rogers mentioned that he has been in contact with KAB about the essential broadcaster badges they are going to issue. You must first pass an online test before applying for the badges. John Beck reported on his experience taking the test. Rogers reported that contract engineers should only need to get a badge from one of their clients.

Rogers also reported on the MBA and KAB Joint Engineering Conference to be held from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm March 16-17 in Overland Park. To attend you must send them a registration fee of \$100 that will be refunded at the Conference.
